It has recently been announced, that WhatsApp will be increasing the minimum age of users from 13 to 16 in the EU, to help them comply with the new data privacy regulations coming into force later this month. In the next few weeks, users will have to sign up to new rules, where they will also be asked to confirm their age. In line with these age restrictions, no child at Westfield should be accessing a WhatsApp account and please can I remind you to be vigilant about what your child/ren are posting on-line, ensure privacy settings are in place and ensure apps are age-appropriate.
