

Speaking and Listening

Practise following adult instructions. Start with a one part instruction then two. For example: Put your coat on the peg. Take your shoes off and take your coat off. Play 'Simon Says.' For example 'Simon says, turn around with your arms folded then touch something red.'

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

As we continue to encourage independence, please help your child to practise putting on and taking off their own jumper/cardigan and coat.

Please also practise different fastenings e.g. zips, buttons and straps.

Phonics



Please look out for the home learning phonics sheets which will be sent out weekly. This will help to consolidate the learning that has taken place each week.

Family Tree

Create a family tree to show who is in your immediate family. Support your child to label the picture e.g. mum, dad, nan.

Maths

To support your child's subitising skills, play games such as dominoes and 'bunny ears.' Say a number from 1-5 and encourage your child to use their fingers (without looking them) to represent the number.



Nature Walk
