You	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inform school of symptoms • Child NOT to attend school • Get a test as soon as possible • Child to isolate for 10 days • Whole household to isolate for 14 days (or until NEGATIVE result received) • Remove all siblings from other bubbles and settings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inform school of symptoms • Child NOT to attend school • Get a test as soon as possible • Household member showing symptoms to isolate for 10 days • Rest of household to isolate for 14 days (or until NEGATIVE result received) • Remove all siblings from other bubbles and settings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inform school that you have been contacted and follow Government guidance as per the NHS Test and Trace website: https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing-and-tracing/nhs-test-and-trace-if-youve-been-in-contact-with-a-person-who-has-coronavirus/
School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All families of bubble informed if a child/member of staff is being tested • All siblings to be removed from other bubbles and settings • If NEGATIVE, bubble will reopen • If POSITIVE, whole bubble will be closed along with any other pupils/adults that have been in close contact and will need to isolate for 14 days (from last day it was open) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School will inform families of the bubble that a child is isolating • Bubble will NOT close • If that child develops symptoms within 2 DAYS, they will be informed to take a test and parents of Bubble notified (refer to information about when a bubble member has symptoms) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School will liaise with family to ascertain if/when child can return to school
