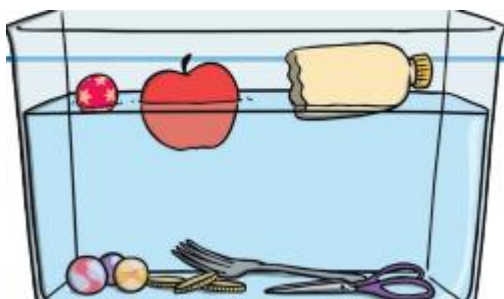

Doubling Machine

- Ask your grown-up to place the same number of things into the doubling machine.
- Give your doubling machine a shake and then count how many things there are altogether. What double did you find?
- Play again with a different number of things.
