

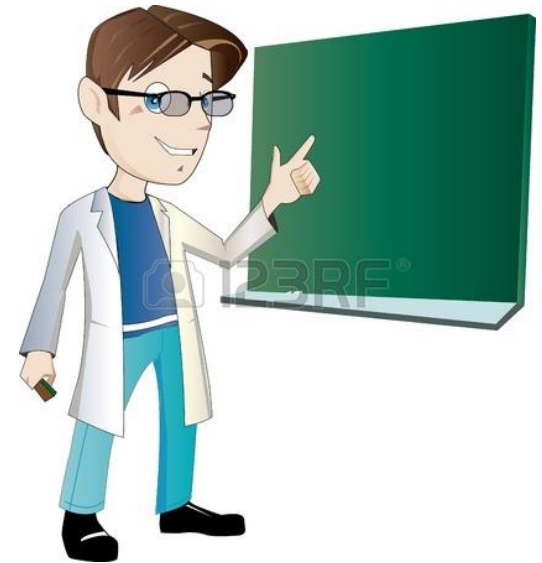


Welcome to Year 6 Westfield Primary School

English

- ***Following 2014 National Curriculum for Year 6***

Maths

New Curriculum – SIGNIFICANTLY raised expectation particularly in fluency within arithmetic.

- Number/Place value/Rounding
- Addition/Subtraction
- Multiplication/Division
- Fractions
- Measures
- Geometry (shape)
- Geometry (position & direction)
- Data



Year 6 covers learning across the Key Stage (Y3/4/5) as it is a spiral curriculum. There will be some repetition.



Homework and Spellings

- Continue daily reading
- New spellings given out on a Monday and tested the following Monday.
- Sentences book given out on Tuesday to be given in on the following Monday.
- Daily Fluency practice will happen at school.
