Bad Weather Procedures

In the event of severe weather conditions, it is occasionally necessary for us to close the school, for the safety of our children, their families and staff. Decisions about closing the school or sending children home early will not be taken lightly and we will always endeavour to open the school when we are safely able to do so.

In the event of snow or bad weather, a decision will be made by the Headteacher and/or members of the Senior Leadership Team and Site Manager regarding whether it is safe to open the school site. If the decision is made to close the school this will be communicated asap via Arbor to parents and carers.
