## A message from Miss Leach

I sometimes get asked what the children have access to that is over and above what we offer in the classroom with quality first teaching.

We have a number of interventions that we run with children around their learning which are mainly classroom based and fluid with the children day to day, this might include handwriting, same day catch up, specific maths and English interventions and small group work.

In addition to this, Miss Powell is our SEN TA and is trained to deliver a number of interventions to support with Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) needs across the school. This might be from a light touch conversation to a structured 12 week programme. External agencies and medical professionals often require us to complete these before we make referrals to them due to growing pressure on their services.



# Some SEMH interventions that we can offer:

- Protective behaviours
- Drawing and talking
- Lego therapy
- Social skills groups
- · 1:1 programmes
- Nurture group

#### **New Summer Term Lunch Menu**

#### Reminder: We are a NUT Free School

Can we please remind you we are a **nut free school**.

Children who suffer from nut allergies can develop a severe, potentially life-threatening allergic reaction.

If someone has a nut allergy it is not just eating nuts that can cause a severe reaction, just being touched on the skin or smelling the breath of someone who has had nuts or a product containing nuts can trigger anaphylactic shock (which can cause breathing and swallowing difficulties).

We cannot have nuts in school in any form so please can we ask that you check all foods and packaging closely before sending them into school either in your child's lunch box, as a snack or brought in as a treat at school pick up time.
