**Dear Parents and Carers** 

Happy New Year to you all from Team Boyce! We hope you've had a wonderful festive break and are ready for the adventures of 2024. We would also like to thank you for all your Christmas cards and thoughtful gifts.

Looking ahead, Team Boyce will be focusing on 'Forces' and then 'Space' in Science; learning about an 'Ancient Chinese Dynasty' in history and making drawstring bags in DT. As more children are beginning to bring phones into school, please allow us to reiterate the following: Year 5 pupils are permitted to have a mobile phone in school, if you wish, for safety reasons on their journeys to and from school. These should be clearly named and handed in to the class teacher each morning to be sent to the office, where they will be kept during the school day. At the end of the day they will be returned to the pupils. Please note- *The school takes no responsibility for any loss or damage to pupil mobile phones.* If your child is walking to and from school independently, please enforce road safety rules including not looking at phones whilst walking and ensure that they cross with the lollypop lady or using the lights.

Please ensure that you closely monitor their safety online.
