Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to a new term and Happy New Year to you all.

This term we are very excited about our residential in March. It's a great opportunity to learn skills that you can't learn in the classroom. It helps the children to put themselves in that stretch zone and have some amazing experiences as a result. It's also an opportunity for them to learn some independence and work on their organisational skills ahead of secondary school. There will be a parent information session held soon. More details on this to follow.

We have a very full timetable this term. In English, we are writing non-chronological reports, balanced arguments and we will be exploring dialogue in more depth. In Science, we are learning about animals including humans. In History, our enquiry question is "What was life like in Baghdad during the Golden Age of Islam?" the children will be using primary and secondary sources to explore and answer this question. Our Geography questions is: Why is Fair Trade fair? In Computing, we are learning about variables in games and spreadsheets. In RE, we will be exploring the question "Is anything ever eternal? And is Christianity still a strong religion 2000 years after Jesus was on Earth?" with a focus on discussion and sharing ideas to construct a point of view. In Art, we will continue with paint and drawing with an added focus on print and textiles. In DT we will be continuing with Chinese Inventions and moving onto exploring bird houses. Our French topics are "Planètes" and "le weekend" we will focus on speaking, listening, reading, and writing different phrases and sentences to describe our weekend and to describe the planets. In PE, we have indoor dance and gymnastics and outdoor netball and OAA (outdoor adventurous activity).

For the Spring term, Year 6 will have P.E. on Monday (Dance) and Tuesday (outside). On these days, please ensure your child is wearing the following to school:

- Blue t-shirt (with the Westfield logo)
- Black or navy shorts / joggers
- Blue jumper (Westfield hoodie, Westfield school jumper or cardigan)
- Trainers

There should not be any other coloured items being worn. Please also ensure that your child is not wearing any branded items with large logos on them. Thank you.

Spellings along with a task in both the English and Maths homework books will be set on a Friday, ready to be marked the following Wednesday.
